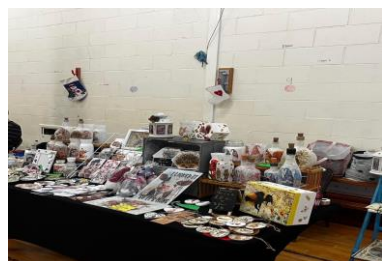
A big thank you!

Class 9

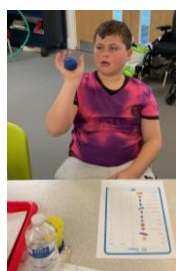
Class 9 have been working on independence skills in food tech, learning about global warming as part of our literacy, working hard in numeracy, and enjoying some turn taking games with each other.
