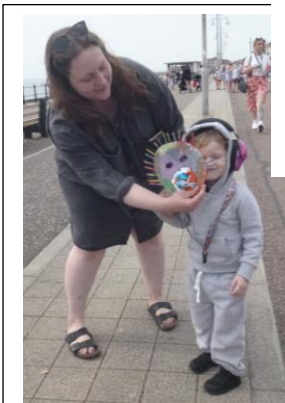
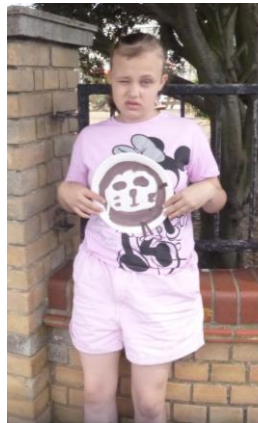


First Light Festival

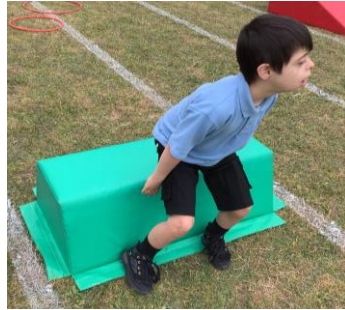

"I enjoying at the backstage it was interesting"

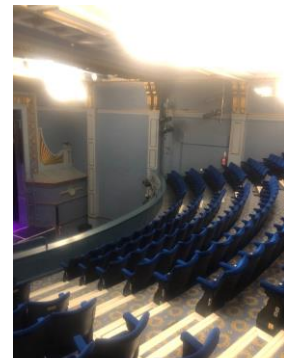
"I liked the sound system."
