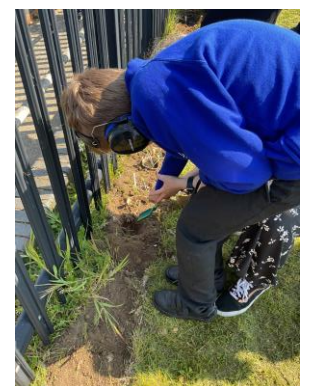
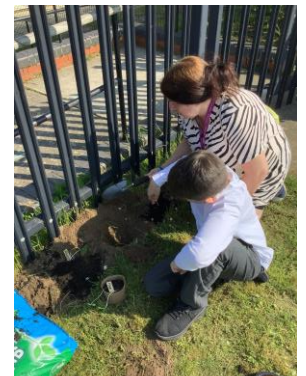
We were blessed with sunshine and the field was alive with smiles, laughter, music and a lot of digging.

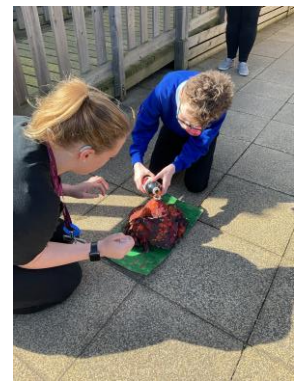


Class 9
