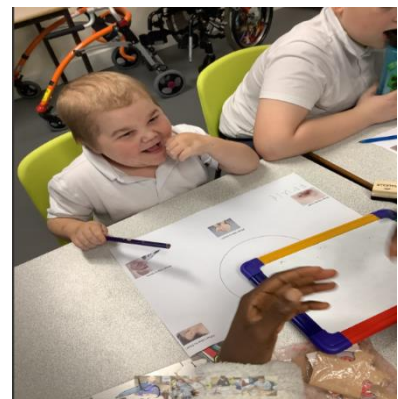
We would like to congratulate Brain (class 14) on becoming a finalist in 'The Education Today Awards' for the following category:

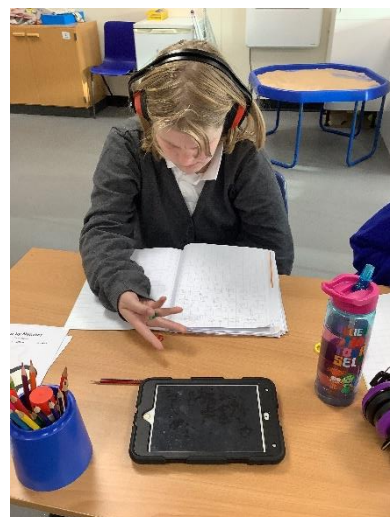
CLASS 14
