Well done, Class 10!



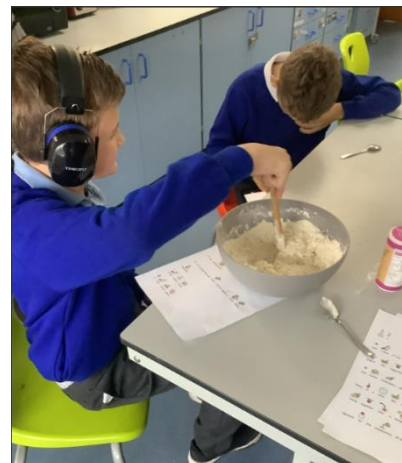
CLASS 11
